We will be working at the WIC/Hartnett Community Garden located at the Outdoor Activity Center in Oakland City. from I-20 exit on Joseph Lowery Boulevard (formerly Ashby Street) just West of the I-75/85 interchange. go south on Lowery to the light and turn RIGHT onto Ralph David Abernathy Boulevard and get in the left lane. when you reach the Kroger (on your left) go straight and turn LEFT at the next light onto Donnelly Street. go to the first light and turn RIGHT onto Oakland (this intersection is shaped like the letter K, you want the arm not the leg). on Oakland go through one traffic light and up the hill then turn RIGHT at the flashing light onto Bridges Ave. go up the hill and the garden will be on your right at the corner of Bridges and Loma Linda.

The garden is located on the back of a 27 acre park called the Outdoor Activity Center. the bathrooms are located at the park office at 1442 Richland Road. you cannot walk from the office/restrooms to the garden, you have to get back in the car and drive. there are also clean public restrooms available at the Kroger if you want to stop on your way past.
